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Ordinance 29  
President and Vice-Chancellor

A. President and Vice-Chancellor

1. The President and Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Council
2. When a vacancy occurs, or is known to be about to occur, in the office of President and Vice-Chancellor, an Appointment Committee of the Council shall be appointed, one of whom shall be eligible to apply for the vacancy, consisting of:
  - a. The Chair of the Council, who shall be Chair of the Appointment Committee;
  - b. Two other independent members appointed by, and from, the Council
  - c. A student representative who is eligible to apply for the vacancy.

- x protecting the reputation of the University;
  - x conferring awards, degrees and other distinctions on individuals as approved by the Senate and Council.
2. The President and Vice-Chancellor may nominate an individual to deputise and attend any meeting or committee in their place
- C. Appointment of an Acting President and Vice-Chancellor
1. In the event of the absence of the President and Vice-Chancellor for more than 3 months, or a vacancy in the office of President and Vice-Chancellor, the Council may appoint an acting President and Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of a selection committee established for this purpose.
  2. The selection committee shall comprise (none of whom shall be eligible to apply for the vacancy):
    - a. The Chair of the Council, who shall be Chair of the Appointment Committee;
    - b. Two other independent members appointed by, and from, the Council;
    - c. A student representative who is a member of Council, appointed by the Students' Union
