

Before Handling and Using Gas Cylinders

You must have received the following training before handling / using cylinders as detailed:

Local Training by a Competent Person eg Technician	Recognised External Training Scheme or Similar
Move cylinders around the workplace <u>EXCEPT</u> acytelene	Moving acytelene cylinders Selection of suitable regulators
Changing the regulator from an empty gas cylinder to a full cylinder of the same gas type	Connecting pipework or equipment to gas cylinders / regulators

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES (excludes acetylene)

Take the following action if a cylinder is dropped:

Other inert gases	Fire Service	
Oxygen	Extinguish ignition sources	Keep people clear

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES - ACETYLENE

Take the following action if an acetylene cylinder is dropped:

Ventilate area. DO NOT put yourself at risk	Evacuate all buildings within 150m of the

IF YOU CANNOT HEAR GAS ESCAPING

Use the back of your hand to check for signs of heating	Use the back of your hand to check for signs of heating	
If the cylinder shows signs of heating evacuate immediately	If the cylinder shows signs of heating clear the area immediately	
Sound the fire alarm	Ensure no one smokes in the area

If the cylinder shows no signs of heating . Check cylinder and valves for damage		
If damaged contact BOC for advice:		
0800 111 333		
If there is no damage and enough space, upright the cylinder (minimum of 2 people)		
Do not use the cylinder , contact BOC on 0800 111 333 to arrange a replacement		
In interim monitor for signs of heating
